They will be leaving school at 9.00 am on Monday 27th August and returning to school on Wednesday 29th August in time for the afternoon bus run. Accommodation will be at the Railway Square YHA, 8-10 Lee Street, Sydney, phone 9281 9666. Travel will be by private car. Breakfasts and accommodation are included with the cost. Dinner and lunches will be provided by the YHA. The children will have dinner on Tuesday night at Pancakes on the Rocks prior to the performance.
