Emergency Bush Fire Plan

Once a year we complete a review of our Emergency Bushfire Plan as our school is located in a bushfire prone area.

If our school was threatened with fire these are the actions we would take:

- Staff and students will assemble in the K-2 classroom which has been built to fire safety standards
- All parents will be contacted by phone and asked to collect their children
- In case of an evacuation of the school, the students and staff will act on the advice of the Bush Fire Captain
- If we need to evacuate the school, children will be transported away from the danger either to the Hall or to Mudgee (in extreme circumstances) depending on the direction that the fire is travelling.
- If you have any concerns please contact the school.

Swimming Lessons

This year swimming lessons will take place from Monday 4th December to Friday 8th December at the Mudgee pool.

We will leave each morning at 11.15 am following morning tea and return in time for the afternoon bus run.

Each day the children will need to take their lunch and water bottle, swimmers, rashie or sun shirt and towel in their swimming bag. New children will be supplied with a swimming bag by the school. If your child does not have a rashie please see Nerida. Please wear school uniform to school each day and covered shoes. We will be providing Cancer Council sunscreen for the children to use. If you do not want your child to use the school sunscreen please feel free to provide your own.

Children will be instructed in small groups according to their swimming ability.

Travel will be by Terry's bus and the Windeyer Hotel bus.
