Guest speaker was Craig Reucassel from the ABC's War on Waste program. The focus of the day was Reduce, Reuse, Recycle. Our students enjoyed making wire flowers with Felicity then learnt how OzHarvest, Australia's leading food rescue charity collect quality surplus food, distribute it to people in need and divert food waste from landfill. After an entertaining talk by Craig Reucassel, our final session was with "Mr Rubbish" from Mid Western Regional Council who taught the children exactly what can be recycled and what can go to the new 'Return & Earn' facility at Jubilee Oval.
