



Currently parents/carers are not permitted to enter the school site unless absolutely necessary.

All visitors to school including parents/carers, contractors including cleaners, service providers and volunteers are required to sign in using the QR code.

This will be an ongoing requirement even when the COVID-19 Public Health Order is inactive.

School students and visitors under the age of 18 do not need to use the check-in system.

We are currently operating under Level 3 restrictions which means:

* Masks or face coverings are recommended for primary students in indoor and outdoor settings on school grounds. Please note they are not mandatory – it is recommended.

*It is mandatory for staff to wear masks in all settings unless they are working in an office on their own; are eating or drinking; they have an existing medical condition; or wearing of the mask alters clear communication or visibility of the person's mouth where it is essential.

*Only essential visitors will be allowed on site and will be required to check in and wear masks at all times.

*There will be enhanced daily cleaning of the school and wherever possible we will ensure classrooms will be well-ventilated with open windows.

Sadly our planned excursion to Canberra has been cancelled (once again) and at this stage all other out-of-school activities and sport will not take place.

Our 5 days of swimming lessons at Mudgee pool have been booked for Monday 29 November to Friday 3 December and we will not know until closer to the date if these will go ahead.


As you all know changing health order restrictions can occur at very short notice.

Sensory Motor Pathway

During the holidays, Debbie our SLSO/OT and Mr Bray created a sensory motor pathway along the K-3 veranda. It gives them that overall important body awareness (proprioceptive input) which improves learning in the classroom.
