Current Covid Rules

We're asking all our families to abide by the current rules to help us return to normality as soon as possible.

If a parent HAS to come into the school they **MUST** sign in and out using the QR code on the office door and comply with mask wearing requirements.

Parents are asked **NOT** to congregate at the front gate of the school, but to maintain social distancing or remain in cars and staff will walk children to the cars. Masks must be worn by parents outside the school gate area.

A reminder for all families

Students should not attend school if unwell, even with mild symptoms of COVID-19.

Any person with any COVID-19 symptoms will be sent home and should not return until they have received a negative test result and are symptom-free.

In circumstances where children have other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms a letter from their GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.

Anyone who is unwell with COVID-19 symptoms is strongly encouraged to get tested and self-isolate until a negative result is received.
