MCubed Challenge wishing Cassie and Savannah all the very best for the MCubed Mathematical Challenge in Mudgee on Tuesday. The girls will form part of a four member small school team competing against teams from Mudgee Public, Cudgegong Valley Public, Gulgong Public and St Matthew's. Teams will be involved in a number of mathematical challenges, some involving group work with lots of problem solving.

Beach to Bush Beach to Bush is Surf Life Saving NSW's flagship educational program, exposing primary school-aged students to important beach and ocean safety messaging. It is the largest surf safety program in the state. The presentation focuses on beach and inland water safety. Students will learn about general beach safety, sun safety, rips and waves, sea creatures, basic first aid, rescues and getting help from a lifeguard. Children from regional and rural parts of NSW are often at higher risk than those from coastal locations because they are less familiar with the beach and unaware of potential surf dangers. The key aquatic safety messages from the program can also be applied to rivers, dams, pools and other inland waterways.
